Colombia's Casa San Agustin rewards guests for excess baggage



Casa San Agustin in Cartagena de Indias, Colombia, is asking all of its guests to pack a donation for underprivileged children this December, and the hotel will provide a food-and-beverage credit and excess baggage fee credit for the trouble.

During December, guests are asked to bring unwrapped gifts of toys, clothes or shoes for children ranging in age from newborn to teens.

The hotel has partnered with 100 Mil Viviendas (100 Thousand Housing), an organization that builds homes to help displaced families living in poverty, and all guest donations will go to that organization.

In return for bringing unwrapped gifts, guests will receive a \$100 food and beverage credit (one per room) for the hotel's Alma restaurant; the hotel will also reimburse guests for the airline excess baggage fees (up to \$50 per person with receipt from the airline).

Nightly rates start at \$370 per room, per night.
